The Kendall County Health Department is currently finishing vaccine distributions to Phase 1A recipients and is beginning to Phase 1B distributions. They have launched a COVID-19 Vaccine Appointment Portal, accepting appointments **only** for eligible individuals who either reside or work in Kendall County. Appointments will fill up fast, but new slots will be added frequently so check back often.
