GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR A FENCE PERMIT

Need to submit:

- 1. Building permit application filled out completely, including cost of job (page 4).
- 2. Copy of the contract. If you are doing the work yourself, note that on the permit application.
- 3. Plat of survey showing the location of the proposed fence with any locations of height change indicated.
- 4. Fence Requirement Worksheet filled out completely (page 3).

All fences shall comply with the following:

- 1. In the front yard, a fence cannot exceed 3 feet in height.
- 2. On corner lots, a fence located within the corner side yard setback shall adhere to the following:
 - a. Maximum height of 3 feet for a solid fence
 - b. Maximum height of 4 feet for an open style (at least 50% open)
- 3. In the rear or interior side yards, a fence shall not exceed 6 feet in height (or shall not exceed 8 feet in height where residential abuts manufacturing or business districts)
- 4. Where applicable, the finished side of a fence or wall must face outward from the lot so that all posts are located on the property owner's side of the fence.
- 5. Fence post holes shall be a minimum of 3 feet in the ground.
- 6. Fence posts and panels shall be placed entirely on the owner's property; no portion of the fence shall be placed directly on or over the property line.
- 7. No portion of a fence can be placed on any part of a restrictive easement, such as a landscape easement or landscape berm.
- 8. No fence shall be constructed in such a way as to block required overland drainage or stormwater easements without Village Engineer approval. The Village Engineer will require stamped engineering plans provided by the applicant showing that the fence will not interfere with the drainage.
- 9. No fence shall be constructed of such height or in such manner as to interfere with the access of light or air to any dwelling unit.
- 10. If a fence must be installed across a property line to complete the fence enclosure, an additional permit is required for the property where this portion of fence is to be placed.
- 11. If the fence is used to meet the pool barrier requirements:
 - a. The fence shall comply with the current code requirements whether the fence is new or replacing an existing fence.
 - b. A separate pool permit application must be submitted in addition to the fence permit application.

<u>Note to Applicant</u>: The final inspection is for verifying height, material, workmanship, and construction requirements. The placement of the fence in relation to the property line is the owner's responsibility. If a homeowner requires verification of the fence placement, a new plat of survey would have to be obtained at the owner's expense.


