GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR A LAWN IRRIGATION SYSTEM PERMIT

Need to submit:

- 1. Building permit application filled out completely, including cost of job for labor & materials (page 2).
- 2. Copy of contract.
- 3. A copy of plumber's license (055 and 058 or Journeyman's License) and 060 irrigation license.
- 4. Plat of survey indicating location of all easements and all proposed sprinkler heads.
- 5. Manufacturer, model, and specifications for the required RPZ (Reduced Pressure Backflow Zone Valve) and device used to interrupt the operation of the landscape irrigation system during periods of rainfall or sufficient ground moisture.
- 6. Documentation indicating:
 - a. Location of R.P.Z. valve
 - b. Location of all existing and proposed electric
 - c. Location of any subsurface seepage system, septic tank, aerobic treatment plant, or distribution box (if applicable)

All Lawn Irrigation Systems shall comply with the following regulations:

- 1. The RPZ shall be protected against freezing by removal when installed outdoors or in locations subject to freezing.
- 2. The RPZ shall not be installed in areas subject to flooding.
- 3. The RPZ shall not be located more than 5 feet above the finished floor or grade.
- 4. Prior to initial operation, the RPZ shall be tested for proper operation by a Cross Connection Control Device Inspector (CCCDI). Records to verify testing and maintenance shall be available at the location where the RPZ is installed, as well as a copy forwarded to the Village of Oswego Building & Permits Department for verification.
- 5. The property owner shall be responsible for testing the RPZ on an annual basis. The results are to be forwarded to the Village of Oswego Building & Permits Department (Ordinance #11-25).
- 6. Provide a drain down valve or other approved means of draining the system. The drain valve shall either be equipped with an anti-siphon device, a vacuum break, or be of a type that a hose cannot be connected to the valve.
- 7. Sprinkler heads are permitted in the parkway, and other utility and Village easements, however, if sprinkler heads are installed in these areas, the Village assumes no liability for the sprinkler system if it is damaged or needs to be replaced or repaired due to required work in these areas. This is solely the homeowner's responsibility.
- 8. Shall meet water sense requirements of the Village of Oswego Municipal Code, Section 8-7-14.
- 9. All the above items are only general requirements and do not represent all the requirements and codes associated with lawn irrigation systems. Each system is reviewed on an individual basis and on existing conditions.
- 10. Contact your Homeowner's Association before you begin work. The Village of Oswego has no authority to enforce the covenants or adopted rules of your Homeowner's Association.
