GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR A PATIO AND SERVICE WALK PERMIT

Need to submit:

- 1. Building permit application filled out completely, including cost of job for labor & materials (page 4).
- 2. Copy of contract (if applicable).
- 3. Plat of survey indicating location of patio and/or service walk.
- 4. Type of material (concrete, pavers, stone, etc.).
- 5. Base material
 - a. Type of base material
 - b. Thickness of base material
- 6. Completed Impervious Surface Worksheet (page 3).

All patios and service walks shall comply with the following regulations:


- 1. The patio or service walk shall be installed on a minimum of a 4 inch compacted approved base material. Paver bricks may require additional base material; refer to the manufacturer's installation instructions for the recommended depth and type of the base materials. Examples of approved base materials:
 - a. Sand
 - b. Washed gravel with a maximum size of ¾ inch material
 - c. Crushed lime stone, such as CA-6
- 2. The surface of the patio or service walk shall slope away from the structure.
- 3. The minimum concrete thickness of a patio or service walk within the boundaries of the owner's property shall be no less than 4 inches thick. The concrete thickness of all public walks shall be no less than 5 inches thick with the portion that passes through the driveway to be no less than 6 inches thick.
- 4. Fill materials shall be free of vegetation and foreign materials. The fill shall be compacted to assure uniform support for the slab, and except where approved, the fill depths shall not exceed 24 inches for clean sand and gravel and 8 inches for earth.
- 5. All concrete exposed to the weather shall conform to the following:
 - a. Provide minimum compression strength of 3500 psi at 28 days after placement.
 - b. The concrete shall be air entrained. Total air content (percent by volume of concrete) shall not be less than 5-percent or more than 7-percent.
 - c. Shall be at least a 6-bag mix.
- 6. The compacted base material does require inspection prior to the placement of any surface material.
- 7. If concrete stairs are being installed as part of the patio, they are required to be framed at the time of the base inspection.
- 8. Fire pits incorporated within a patio shall be placed a minimum of 15 feet from the primary structure and 10 feet from any other combustible materials, structures on the property, and property line. Sizing shall be restricted to 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet in depth.
- 9. Any steps installed in conjunction with the patio are required to conform to the following:



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a. When a stair section for an exterior door contains more than two risers, a landing shall be provided for that exterior door. The landing shall measure 3 feet in the direction of travel for the full width of the door opening.



- b. Stair guards are required on stair sections containing 3 or more risers or a total rise of 15 ½ inches or more.
- c. The maximum riser height shall be 7 3/4 inches.
- d. The minimum tread depth shall be 10 inches, measured from nosing to nosing (11 inches without a nosing).
- e. The maximum differential between all treads, as well as all risers, shall be no more than 3/8 inch.
- 10. Any stair sections containing three or more risers or with a total rise of 15 ½ inches or more would require a handrail to be installed:
 - a. All handrails shall be continuous for the full length of the stairs, from a point directly above the top riser to a point directly above the bottom riser of the flight of stairs.
 - b. Installed at a height of 34-38 inches, measured vertically from the nosing of the tread.
 - c. Designed to withstand a concentrated load of 200 pounds.
 - d. All handrails are to be gripable and return at ends.

Note for applicant: Contact your Homeowner's Association before you begin work. The Village of Oswego has no authority to enforce the covenants or adopted rules of your Homeowner's Association.



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IMPERVIOUS SURFACE WORKSHEET INCLUDE WITH PERMIT APPLICATION

Residential lots have a maximum impervious surface coverage requirement. "Impervious Surface" refers to surfaces that alter the natural course or rate of absorption of stormwater, and may include, but is not limited to, principal structures, accessory structures, decks, walkways, paved parking lots, and paved driveways.

To assist staff in calculating the impervious surface of your property, please provide the below

information with your permit application:
