INVESTIGATIONS

Investigation Spotlight

A detective met with an Assistant State's Attorney and reviewed an ongoing case from 2020 that involved an incident at a local bar/restaurant, where a DJ allegedly battered a patron. The case took months to pursue due to uncooperative witnesses/employees of the establishment. Grand Jury requests for their testimony were required and one did not show. At this time, evidence has been gathered to approve a felony battery charge in a public place and a warrant is being authorized. This same subject was charged previously in 2019 for a felony battery at the same establishment for battering an employee.
