CALEA On-Site Assessment
August 9-11, 2021**



The Oswego Police Department is scheduled for a virtual on-site assessment the week of August 9, 2021, as part of a voluntary, nationally recognized program to achieve reaccreditation by verifying it meets strict professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards and performs an examination of all aspects of the department's policy and procedures, administration, operations, support services and adherence to the CALEA professional standards. The Oswego Police Department has been accredited since 2005.

As part of the site-based assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session on Tuesday, August 10, 2021, at 5 p.m. The session will be conducted virtually with the assessment team via Zoom Meetings in the Oswego Police Department Community Room at 3355 Woolley Road, in Oswego.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by calling (630) 551-7300 on Monday, August 9, 2021, between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Comments will be taken by the Assessment Team.

Telephone comments as well as appearances at the public information session are limited to ten minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA's standards.
