#### **Investigation Spotlight**

A Detective investigated a 15-year-old female juvenile that was missing for 26 days before being recovered with assistance from the Department of Children and Family Services. The detective also worked with the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children to assist in public messaging. Our Detective used social media and internet service provider information to hone in on an area in Chicago where the runaway was believed to be located. Our Detective also went to that neighborhood and developed informants who reported real time information on her whereabouts. All of that work created an opportunity for the juvenile to eventually be recovered.
