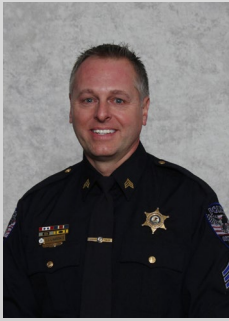

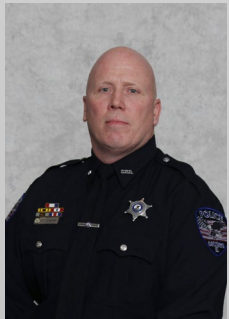

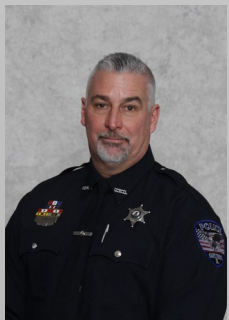

### Raising Awareness for Fallen Officers

There have been an increasing number of police officers killed in the line of duty. This is an unfortunate trend that we have seen hit too close to home. Each one of these officers that paid the ultimate sacrifice leaves behind a grieving family. We want to pay tribute to the fallen officer's dedication and support their family. We have partnered with Illinois Concerns of Police Survivors (ILCOPS), a non for profit organization to raise awareness and funds to be provided to the family left behind.

Sgt. Nehring will be completing the 4 x 4 x 48 Challenge on March 4<sup>th</sup> hosted at Yorkville Crossfit to do such that. The challenge consists of completing 4 miles every 4 for hours for 48 hours no matter the weather conditions. A challenge that will task the body physically and mentally, but is small sacrifice compared to the fallen officers.

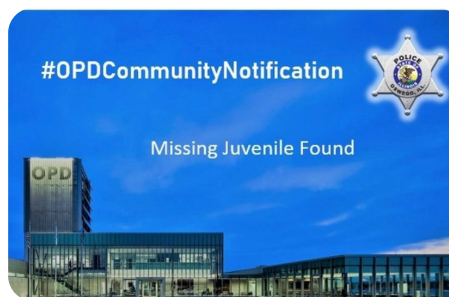
