Salary range effective 5/1/22 is \$78,371.98 to \$82,682.44 with a top out of \$107,321.24

QUALIFICATIONS / REQUIREMENTS THAT MUST BE MET BY WEDNESDAY, July 27, 2022

- ◆ **State of Illinois Law Enforcement Certification** from the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board as a law enforcement officer in good standing (part-time certification as a law enforcement does not meet this requirement), and
- ◆ Applicants shall be employed for a minimum of two consecutive years with their current agency as a fulltime Sworn Municipal Officer, Illinois State Trooper or County Sheriff's Deputy AND they must have completed their probationary period as of **JULY 27, 2022**, and
- ◆ Currently in good standing with the police department in which the person serves or is laid-off due to budgetary restraints with that agency, and
- ◆ Possess the knowledge, skills, abilities and level of experience required pursuant to the call for qualified lateral transfer applicants, and
- ◆ Must be a United States Citizen and have a Valid Driver's License by July 27, 2022, and
- ◆ Has a Bachelor or Associate Degree in any field of study (OR 60 credit hours at an accredited college or university) OR those who qualify for a waiver due to active military service pursuant to statute [(65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-6) (from Ch. 24, par. 10-2.1-6)], by July 27, 2022, and
- ◆ Must pass written examination, oral interview, in-depth background investigation, which includes a polygraph, and
- ◆ After conditional job offer, must pass Medical (including drug screen, hearing and eye exam) and Psychological examinations

APPLICATIONS

- ◆ Applications are available beginning June 13, 2022 and a non-refundable fee of \$25.00 is required at the time of submittal. Applications may be completed online from our recruiting website at www.opdrecruits.com or through www.oswegoil.org
- ◆ Applications must be submitted by 4:00pm (CST) on Wednesday, July 27, 2022. Applications and payments are only accepted online through the website
- ◆ Only the application and fee will be submitted; a resume, certificates and/or transcript copies, etc. are NOT needed at this time, but should be immediately available at the request of a background

NEXT STEP IN TESTING PROCESS ONCE APPLICATION & FEE IS SUBMITTED

- ◆ **MUST ATTEND MANDATORY ORIENTATION, WRITTEN EXAMINATION AND ORAL INTERVIEW**, which will be held in Oswego on **Monday, August 1, 2022 at 8:00AM**. Applicants must have photo identification, which can be a State ID, Driver's License or Passport
