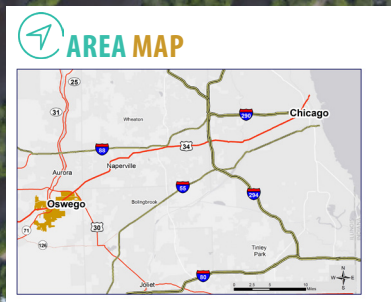

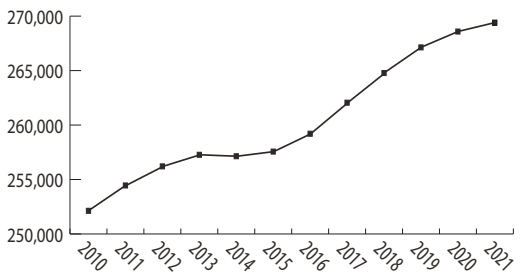

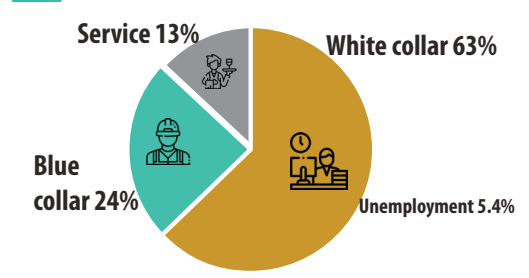

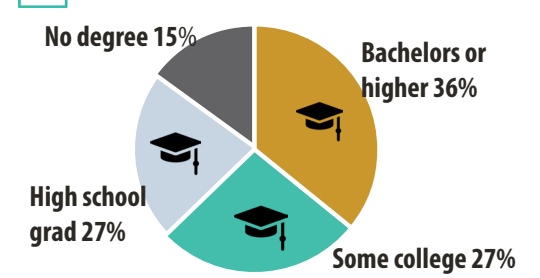
## POPULATION TREND 15-MINUTE DRIVETIME
